Notice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Applicant must enter Thailand on the date specified in the airline ticket or ticket reservation confirmation ● Upon arrival to Thailand, the period of stay is granted by an immigration officer in accordance with the type of visa; travelers who wish to stay longer than the granted period must file an application for permission of extension of stay at offices of the Immigration Bureau of Thailand; the extension of stay as well as the change of certain type of visa is solely at the discretion of the Immigration officer in Thailand. ● In case that visa application is rejected, the application will not be refunded and submitted documents will not be returned to applicant ● The following required documents might be change without prior notice ● The Royal Thai Embassy in Tokyo reserves the right to request additional documents as deemed necessary and reserves the right to reject an application without providing any reasons ● Fraud or misrepresentation can result in permanent visa ineligibility 		

Required Documents

1. Passport and a copy of passport photo page

- Passport with validity not less than 6 months
- At least 2 blank pages left
- One copy of passport photo page

2. Visa Application Form

- One Visa Application Form completely filled out and signed as the same as the applicant's passport signature

3. One Photograph

- Size 3.5 cm × 4.5 cm
- Colour photograph taken within the last 3 months
- Attach the photograph to the Visa Application Form
- Note that the number of photographs required depending on the applicant's nationality, please check the Additional Required Documents for Non-Japanese Applicants below

4. Personal History

- One Personal History completely filled out and signed as the same as the applicant's passport signature

5. One original Letter of Approval issued by the Thailand Film Office, Office of Tourism Development, Ministry of Tourism and Sports of Thailand

6. One original Invitation Letter issued by prospective employer in Thailand

- Must be an original document written in English language (PDF or fax copy is not acceptable)
- Must have the company's letter head
- Must address to " Visa Section of the Royal Thai Embassy, Tokyo
- Must contain the applicant's name / assignment's position in Thailand / purpose of entry / date of entry / length of stay / type of visa
- Must sign by the authorized person(s) (electronic signature is not acceptable) whose name(s) listed in the company's registration (Copy of the company's registration issued by the Ministry of Commerce of Thailand within 6 months is required) and must include company's seal
- In case that a signature of authorized person(s) in the Invitation Letter is absent, a letter of power of attorney authorizing other person(s) to act on his/her behalf must be submitted upon submitting the visa application

7. One copy of company's registration issued by the Ministry of Commerce of Thailand

- Must be issued within 6 months

8. Recommendation Letter issued by the current employer / organization in Japan

- Must be an original Recommendation Letter written in English (PDF or fax copy is not acceptable)
- Must have the company's letter head
- Must address to "Visa Section of the Royal Thai Embassy, Tokyo"
- Must contain the applicant's name / assignment's position / responsibilities / salary / date of entry / length of stay and type of visa
- Must sign by the authorized person(s) (electronic signature is not acceptable) whose name(s) listed in the company's registration and include company's seal

9. One copy of confirmed airline ticket paid in full or ticket reservation confirmation

- The confirmed airline ticket paid in full or ticket reservation confirmation must be issued by airline or travel company and must contain the applicant's name, flight number and date arrival

Additional Required Documents for Non-Japanese Applicants

10. One copy of residence card or certificate of alien registration

(On the applying date, please present the original document of identification)

- Valid for at least 3 months
- For those who are currently applying for renewal of residence card, please submit a copy of acceptance of renewal issued by the Immigration Bureau of Japan

11. The original company's registration issued by the Ministry of Justice of Japan (Only the listed countries below)

- Must be issued within 6 months

12. Additional Photograph(s) (Only for the applicant from the listed countries below)

- Applicant with nationality of No. 1-28, please provide 3 photographs
- Applicant with nationality of No. 29-30, please provide 4 photographs
