Notice	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Applicant must enter Thailand on the date specified in the airline ticket or ticket reservation confirmation● Upon arrival to Thailand, the period of stay is granted by an immigration officer in accordance with the type of visa; travelers who wish to stay longer than the granted period must file an application for permission of extension of stay at offices of the Immigration Bureau of Thailand; the extension of stay as well as the change of certain type of visa is solely at the discretion of the Immigration officer in Thailand● In case that visa application is rejected, the visa fee will not be refunded and the submitted documents will not be returned to the applicant● The following required documents are subject to change without prior notice● The Royal Thai Embassy in Tokyo reserves the right to request additional documents as deemed necessary and reserves the right to reject an application without providing any reasons● Fraud or misrepresentation can result in permanent visa ineligibility		

Required Documents

1. Passport and a copy of passport photo page

- Passport with validity not less than 6 months
- At least 2 blank pages left
- One copy of passport photo page

2. Visa Application Form

- One Visa Application Form completely filled out and signed as the same as the applicant's passport signature

3. One Photograph

- Size 3.5 cm × 4.5 cm
- Colour photograph taken within the last 3 months
- Attach the photograph to the Visa Application Form
- Note that the number of photographs required depending on the applicant's nationality, please check the Additional Required Documents for Non-Japanese Applicants below

4. Personal History

- One Personal History completely filled out and signed as the same as the applicant's passport signature
(downloadable at <https://site.thaiembassy.jp/upload/pdf/about-visa-personalhistory.pdf>)

5. One copy of Approval Letter issued by the National Research Council of Thailand (NRCT)

- Must be issued within 3 months

6. Invitation Letter issued by educational / research institute in Thailand

- Must be an original Invitation Letter written in English (PDF or fax copy is not acceptable)
- Must have the letter head of educational / research institute in Thailand
- Must address to “Visa Section of the Royal Thai Embassy, Tokyo”
- Must contain the applicant's name / assignment's position in Thailand / date of entry / length of stay / type of visa
- Must sign by the authorized person(s) (electronic signature is not acceptable) whose name(s) listed in the educational / research institute's registration and must include the seal of education / research institute in Thailand
- In case that a signature of authorized person(s) in the Invitation Letter is absent, a letter of power of attorney authorizing other person(s) to act on his/her behalf must be submitted upon submitting the visa application

7. Recommendation Letter issued by the current educational / research institute / company in Japan

- Must be an original Recommendation Letter written in English (PDF or fax copy is not acceptable)
- Must have the letter head of educational / research institute / company in Japan
- Must address to “Visa Section of the Royal Thai Embassy, Tokyo”
- Must contain the applicant's name / assignment's position in Japan / date of entry / length of stay / type of visa
- Must sign by the authorized person(s) (electronic signature is not acceptable) whose name(s) listed in the educational / research institute / company's registration and must include the seal of the educational / research institute / company in Japan

※ **In case of personal research, an original Guarantee Letter must be presented, together with a copy of guarantor's passport or driving license duly signed by the guarantor**

Guarantee Letter (downloadable at <https://site.thaiembassy.jp/upload/iblock/4ef/guarantee.pdf>)

- A guarantor must be 20 years of age or older, must be able to confirm the applicant's personal attributes. A guarantor must be available to be contacted by the Embassy and must not be a person who will accompany the applicant to Thailand
- A guarantor who are not Japanese national must provide a copy of passport and residence card (legally residing in Japan)
- In the English Guarantee Letter, a guarantor must sign as the same as the guarantor's identification document signature
- Japanese guarantor who prefers to use driver license, please sign as the same as signature in the guarantor letter on the copy of driver license

8. One copy of confirmed airline ticket paid in full or ticket reservation confirmation

- The confirmed airline ticket paid in full or ticket reservation confirmation must be issued by airline or travel company and must contain the applicant's name, flight number and date arrival

Additional Required Documents for Non-Japanese Applicants

9. One copy of residence card or certificate of alien registration

(On the applying date, please present the original document of identification)

- Valid for at least 3 months
- For those who are currently applying for renewal of residence card, please submit a copy of acceptance of renewal issued by the Immigration Bureau of Japan

10. Additional Photograph(s) (Only for the applicant from the listed countries below)

- Applicant with nationality of No. 1-28, please provide 3 photographs
- Applicant with nationality of No. 29-30, please provide 4 photographs
