

Required documents to present at the airport check-in counter and upon arrival into Thailand

1. Copy of valid passport
2. Copy of valid Thai visa or re-entry permit (if applicable)
3. COE (Certificate of Entry)
4. **Health insurance which covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of USD 100,000.** (The period must cover the length of stay in Thailand. However, for non-Thai nationals who hold Thai residence or who intend to stay long-term, the health insurance must cover at least one-year period.)
5. Vaccination Certificate (if any)
* Vaccination Certificate (Vaccine Passport) must be issued by government authority.
6. Air ticket
7. AQ / SHA+ / Samui Extra Plus hotel reservation document
8. **Medical certificate** with a laboratory result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected, **using RT-PCR test, issued within 72 hours before departure** (in case of connecting flights, before embarkation from initial port).
9. T.8 Form (Health Declaration Form)

10. Receipt of COVID test appointment (For Sandbox Programme)
