## Required documents to present at the airport check-in counter and upon arrival into Thailand

- 1. Copy of valid passport
- 2. Copy of valid Thai visa or re-entry permit (if applicable)
- 3. COE (Certificate of Entry)
- 4. Health insurance which covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of USD 100,000. (The period must cover the length of stay in Thailand. However, for non-Thai nationals who hold Thai residence or who intend to stay long-term, the health insurance must cover at least one-year period.)
- 5. Vaccination Certificate (if any)
  - \* Vaccination Certificate (Vaccine Passport) must be <u>issued by government</u> authority.
- 6. Air ticket
- 7. AQ / SHA+ / Samui Extra Plus hotel reservation document
- 8. **Medical certificate** with a laboratory result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected, **using RT-PCR test**, **issued within 72 hours before departure** (in case of connecting flights, before embarkation from initial port).
- 9. T. 8 Form (Health Declaration Form) Please download at https://drive.google.com/file/d/1GCRRpFhnOcSTfUZkQD\_Mx9X\_Q2dCQvKG/view
- 10. Receipt of COVID test appointment (For Sandbox Programme)
