Notice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Employment in Thailand is prohibited ● Applicant must enter Thailand on the date specified in the airline ticket or ticket reservation confirmation ● Upon arrival to Thailand, for travellers who wish to request for a permission to extend stay permit, please contact directly to the Immigration Bureau of Thailand ● In case that visa application is rejected, the visa fee will not be refunded and the submitted documents will not be returned to the applicant ● The following required documents are subject to change without prior notice ● The Royal Thai Embassy in Tokyo reserves the right to request additional documents as deemed necessary and reserves the right to reject an application without providing any reasons ● Fraud or misrepresentation can result in permanent visa ineligibility 		

Required Documents

1. Passport and a copy of passport photo page

- Passport with validity not less than 6 months
- At least 2 blank pages left
- One copy of passport photo page

1. Visa Application Form

- One Visa Application Form completely filled out and signed as the same as the applicant's passport signature
 (downloadable at <https://site.thaiembassy.jp/upload/pdf/about-visa-visaN.pdf>)

2. One Photograph

- Size 3.5 cm × 4.5 cm
- Color photograph taken within the last 3 months
- Attach the photograph to the Visa Application Form
- Note that the number of photographs required depending on the applicant's nationality, please check the additional required documents for Non-Japanese Applicants below

3. Personal History

- One Personal History completely filled out and signed as the same as the applicant's passport signature
(downloadable at <https://site.thaiembassy.jp/upload/pdf/about-visa-personalhistory.pdf>)

4. One copy of confirmed airline ticket paid in full or ticket reservation confirmation

- The confirmed airline ticket paid in full or ticket reservation confirmation must be issued by airline or travel company and must contain the applicant's name, flight number and date arrival (to and from Thailand)

5. One original bank statement of the applicant in English language

- The bank statement must contain the amount equivalent to at least 20,000 Baht per person
- In case of applicant under the age of 20 years who do not have a bank account of their own, must provide a bank statement of either the father or the mother with the amount equivalent to at least 40,000 Baht per family; and must provide one original family registration certificate in Japan (KOSEKITOHON) issued within 3 months
- Please note that a copy of bank book is not acceptable

6. For the applicant who wishes to enter Thailand during their transit, please provide the evidence of accommodations for the entire duration of stay in Thailand (one of the following documents from 7.1-7.4 is required)

7.1 Hotel reservation

7.2 Copy of the applicant's own evidence for condominium / apartment / house

7.3 In case of renting condominium / apartment / house, a copy of the lease agreement and landlord's Identification Card (ID Card) is required

7.4 In case of staying with friend or family, the following documents from A-D is required

A. Invitation Letter from friend or family (including name of the writer, relationship with the applicant, address for staying, length of stay, contact, and signature of the writer)

B. In case of owning or renting condominium / apartment / house, a copy of the applicant's own evidence or the lease agreement

C. One copy of Identification Card (ID Card) of friend or family

➤ In case of Thai national, must submit a copy of ID card and House Registration which include address and name

➤ In case of foreigner, must submit a copy of passport (photo page and valid visa pages) and, in case of foreigner legally working in Thailand, must also submit a copy of valid work permit

D. Official documents proving family relationship

➤ For Japanese national, must submit one original family registration certificate of Japan (KOSEKITOHON) issued within 3 months

➤ For foreigners, must submit one copy of Registration of Marriage with English translation or Birth Certificate with English translation

7. Occupation's documents

8.1 For Employee of a company

- One original certificate of employment
- One original company's approval letter to take holiday / vacation leave
- One original company's registration (TOKIBOTOHON) issued within 3 months

8.2 For Owner of company / Self-employed

- One original company's registration (TOKIBOTOHON) issued within 3 months

8.3 For Student

- One original certificate of enrollment issued by the academic institution in Japan

8.4 For Pensioner

- One original certificate and one copy of pensioner's fund stating the amount of pension received

8.5 For Housewife / Househusband

- For Japanese national, must submit one original family registration certificate of Japan (KOSEKITOHON) issued within 3 months and one copy of photo-page passport
- For Foreigner with Japanese spouse, must submit one original of the spouse's family registration certification of Japan (KOSEKITOHON) issued within 3 months and one copy of photo-page passport
- For Foreigner, must submit one copy of Registration of Marriage with English translation or Birth Certificate with English translation

8.6 For applicant aged under 20 years

- One original guarantee letter must be presented, together with a copy of guarantor's passport or driving license duly signed by the guarantor

- A guarantor must be 20 years of age or older, must be able to confirm the applicant's personal attributes. A guarantor must be available to be contacted by the Embassy and must not be a person who will accompany the applicant to Thailand
- A guarantor who are not Japanese national must provide a copy of passport and residence card (legally residing in Japan)
- In the English Guarantee Letter, a guarantor must sign as the same as the guarantor's identification document signature
- Japanese guarantor who prefers to use driver license, please sign as the same as signature in the guarantor letter on the copy of driver license

- **Official documents proving family relationship with the applicant**

- For Japanese national, an original Household Registration issued within 3 months
- For Non-Japanese nationality, birth certificate of your country with English translation is required

8.7 For unemployed applicant

- One original certificate of personal income tax or personal income tax exemption
- One original guarantee letter must be presented, together with a copy of guarantor's passport or driving license duly signed by the guarantor

- A guarantor must be 20 years of age or older, must be able to confirm the applicant's personal attributes. A guarantor must be available to be contacted by the Embassy and must not be a person who will accompany the applicant to Thailand
- A guarantor who are not Japanese national must provide a copy of passport and residence card (legally residing in Japan with permanent residence)
- In the English Guarantee Letter, a guarantor must sign as the same as the guarantor's identification document signature

- Japanese guarantor who prefers to use driver license, please sign as the same as signature in the guarantor letter on the copy of driver license

8. Tentative programmes in Thailand from the date of entry to departure from Thailand

- Must be in English language only
- Explain in details for all schedules including accommodations, places to visit, means of transportation, and purpose of visit in each place and activity plan
- There is no specific form required

Additional Required Documents for Non-Japanese Applicants

9. One copy of residence card or certificate of alien registration

(On the applying date, please present the original document of identification)

- Valid for at least 3 months
- For those who are currently applying for renewal of residence card, please submit a copy of acceptance of renewal issued by the Immigration Bureau of Japan

10. One original guarantee letter must be presented, together with a copy of guarantor's passport or driving license duly signed by the guarantor

- A guarantor must be 20 years of age or older, must be able to confirm the applicant's personal attributes. A guarantor must be available to be contacted by the Embassy and must not be a person who will accompany the applicant to Thailand
